With reference to: BS Smith, “Statutory discretion or common law power? Some reflections on ‘veil piercing’ and the consideration of (the value of) trust assets in dividing matrimonial property at divorce – Part Two”, *Journal for Juridical Science*, Vol. 42, 1(2017), 1-18 the following:

After publication, it was brought to the author’s attention that when quoting the Supreme Court of Appeal case of *Mills v Mills* [2016] ZASCA 5 (9 March 2017) as supporting his conclusion (on pp 15, 16), the author omitted a footnote in which the court specifically referred to another recent publication on the same topic as this article. The omitted reference is Iain M Shipley “Trust assets and the dissolution of a marriage: a practical look at invalid trusts, sham trusts, and piercing the veneers of trusts/going behind the trust form” (2016) 28 SA Merc LJ 508. The author accepts an independent reviewer’s finding that his decision – albeit made in good faith – to omit the footnote and any reference to that article was incorrect. The editor hereby wishes to alert the reader to the fact that the article should be read as if the omitted reference appears in the quote. The reader is also alerted to the fact that a number of the conclusions proffered by the authors in their respective articles, albeit reached independently, overlap. Both works should thus be consulted.
